

2018 Non-profit Satellite Account

At the end of March 2020 Statistics NZ released the results of the Non-profit Satellite Account (NPISA).

Non-profit institutions satellite account (NPISA) provides information about the contribution non-profit institutions (NPIs) make to the New Zealand economy and measures of volunteering and unpaid work. NPISA supplements the existing New Zealand System of National Accounts (NZSNA).

The Report is summarised by Charles Crothers as follows:

This (as in earlier versions for 2013 and 2004) adds the value generated by this sector to the National Economy (as measured by New Zealand System of National Accounts (NZSNA)), together with measures of volunteering and unpaid work.

A NPI must meet the following five criteria:

- be organised to the extent that they can be separately identified
- be not for profit and not distribute any surplus they may generate to those who own or control them
- be institutionally separate from government
- be in control of their own destiny
- be non-compulsory in both terms of membership and members' input.

The report is supplemented by sets of downloadable tables. The results provided compare data at year ended March 2018 with year ended March 2013 (and the report includes some comparisons with 2004). Information covers:

- total expenditure and its components (salaries and wages, donations, grants, investment)
- total employment remuneration, including an estimate of the value of formal unpaid labour

- operating surplus and savings
- number of institutions by type (e.g. environment, health, social services)
- number of paid employees
- value of volunteers.

A 12-category classification is used with the first two categories further subdivided.

The information is variously obtained from:

- Stats NZ's Business Register
- registers of incorporated societies and charitable trusts held by the Companies office
- registers of charities maintained by Charities Service
- membership registers of umbrella organisations for sporting bodies etc.
- lists of institutions published by grant-making organisations
- other administrative sources.

The lists are sieved to prevent double counting.

Statistics NZ summary is that:

- NPIs' contribution to GDP in 2018 was \$8.1 billion (2.8 percent of GDP) compared with \$6.2 billion (2.9 percent of GDP) in 2013.
- The value of volunteering is estimated at \$4 billion.
- Membership, donations, and grants (including government grants) make up 29 percent of NPI income.
- The number of paid employees in the NPI sector has increased 10 percent to 150,630.
- Volunteer hours have remained stable at 159 million.
